The stone's oath By Volva-Kaðlín knutr

s Their Majesties, Brennan IV and Caoilfhionn IV, were saying goodbye to their populous during their final court the light vanished and the kingdom was cast in shadows. In the inky darkness, a voice cried out, "It has been foretold that an eclipse will come". Queen Caoilfhionn was saddened as there was not a King or Queen to brighten the lands. But King Brennen, with a mischievous glint in his eye, proclaimed, "But we have heirs. We could make this work"

Prince Matthias Grunewald and Princess Æsa feilinn Jossursdottir were called to the hall. A song could be heard, the voices echoing off the rafters. Candles carried by friends lighted the heirs's path as they were guided to the dais. Once they were presented, all witnessed a podium placed in front of the

thrones, upon it a large grey rock was perched. It's not a rock you would think would be special, teardrop-shaped with a few shallow divots. EVERGREEN

enchantment

The wonderful thing about the festivals of the winter solstice is that they're an amalgam of different cultures' festive customs. For instance, the custom of bringing evergreens into the house around the time of the winter solstice dates back to ancient pagan times. The Romans brought greenery into their houses at Saturnalia. Also, pagan civilizations across Northern Europe would make a sacrifice to the Norse god Jul by bringing evergreens, called Jul trees, into the home to bless and protect the family.

Let's plant our own Jul trees for some winter fun:

- First, you need to go for a walk in the woods and find some freshly fallen pine cones.
- Bring them home and put them in a paper bag, and place them in the freezer for a few days (this part is important).
- Put some soil in a pot with a hole in it. Shake the pine cone seeds out of your pine cone and cover them with soil.
- You might want to plant the pine cone partially into the soil too because it looks pretty cool.
- Water your seeds with a little water every day. They should start to sprout in about a week.

Be sure to water your Jul Tree often. When it starts to get too big for its pot, regime it into a larger one. Keep watch and care for your tree and by next year you will be able to decorate it with your own ornaments.
